Odisha State GST records progressive growth of 29.59% upto August '22

- 1) Odisha has recorded an OGST collection of Rs. 1019.81 Cr. during August '22 against Rs. 956.47 Cr during August'21 with a growth of 6.62%. The progressive collection of OGST till August'22 is Rs. 6267.93 Cr against Rs. 4836.75 Cr with a growth rate of 29.59%.
- 2) The Gross collection of GST during August '22 is Rs.3883.90 Cr as against Rs. 3316.55 Cr during August '21 with a growth of 17.11%. The progressive collection of Gross GST till August' 22 is Rs. 20366.77 Cr against Rs. 16977.92 Cr with a growth rate of 19.96%.
- 3) The total collection of VAT (Petrol & Liquor) is Rs. 933.62Cr. during August'22 as against Rs.884.22 Cr. during August'21 with growth rate of 5.59%.
- 4) Out of the above, collection from Petroleum Products is Rs. 750.11 Cr during August'22 against Rs. 727.73 Cr. collected during August '21with growth of 3.08%. Similarly, the collection from liquor is Rs 183.51Crduring August'22 against Rs. 156.49 Cr. collected during August'21 with growth rate of 17.27%.
- 5) There is also a growth of 18.37% in Profession Tax with a collection of Rs. 21.72 Cr. during August'22 against collection of Rs. 18.35 Cr during August'21.
- 6) During the current FY (upto August), 20269 nos. of new taxpayers have been bought under the GST fold. The total e-waybill generated during August '22 was 15.81Lakh against 14.35 Lakh during August'21 witnessing a growth of 10.17%.
- 7) The Commissionerate is also regularly contacting the stakeholders who have visited Circles with various grievances relating to registration and return filing under the MoSarkar feedback programme. The tax officers have been instructed to adhere to the principles of 5T as well as attend to the genuine grievances of the taxpayers promptly.
